We are delighted to announce the 7th International Analysis and Activism Conference, to be held in Mexico City, October 30 – November 1, 2026.

Our theme, "Transcending Divisions: Borders, Identity, and the Rekindling of Our Shared Humanity", responds to the global resurgence of authoritarianism, hardened borders, nativism, and anti-immigrant policies. Following Jung, Hillman, Anzaldúa, and others, we invite proposals exploring borders—inner and outer—as literal and symbolic sites of trauma, resilience, exclusion, and transformation. We welcome contributions from historically underrepresented regions and emphasize accessibility with fees adjusted to socioeconomic realities. The conference will run from **Friday**, **October 30 through Sunday**, **November 1.** Participants may extend their stay to join the Día de los Muertos (Day of the Dead) celebrations on November 1–2, one of Mexico's most significant cultural traditions.
